\_\_\_ Little Miss Honey (Age 5-8) OR \_\_\_ Junior Miss (Age 9-12)

1. Applications are due by Sept. 4, 2023, Pageant is Sept. 9, 2023, 10:00 am.
2. Contestants must be
  - a. Age 9-12 for Junior Miss, or 5-8 for Little Miss as of Sept. 9, 2023.
  - b. A resident of Doddridge County
3. Contestants will demonstrate good sportsmanship, be responsible for their possessions, and respect the belongings of others.
4. Contestants will be judged on their presentation in their Future Occupation Attire and Sunday Best, and the onstage interview.
5. Festival and pageant staff will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
6. Dressing Room Rules
  - a. No camera or cell phone use
  - b. No food or drink except water
  - c. Backstage helpers will be strictly limited
7. Winners receive a crown, sash and gift basket, all participants will receive a gift.
8. Winners will attend the Ephraim Bee Festival the rest of the day
9. Winners are expected to promote the Ephraim Bee Festival. This can be as visiting royalty at pageants, events and parades. Every effort should be made to attend the parades at Doddridge Homecoming, Salem Apple Butter, West Union Veterans Day, and Christmas in Doddridge Celebration.
10. Winners are expected to represent themselves, the festival and the Chamber of Commerce in a positive manner when in public.
11. Decisions of the director are final.
